This is why we encourage the police and military women of Europe, so that their union or professional organizations are associated in platforms or similar models, to be visible in the respective countries, and to forge an effective collaboration in their governing bodies, putting in value new projects to advance, expand and improve the presence of women who are working for and because of safety.
